Privacy Policy of "APŁ JDS Environmental Lawyers" – legal advisors running cooperating law firms: Aneta Pacek-Łopalewska Legal Advisor Office and Joanna Daniłowicz-Starościak Law Firm.

Processing and Protection of Personal Data

General

1. This privacy policy (hereinafter: "Privacy Policy") is the implementation of the information obligations imposed on the personal data controller by Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter: "GDPR") and in Polish regulations issued in connection with the GDPR, including the Act of 10 May 2018 on the protection of personal data.
2. The Privacy Policy defines the rules for the processing of personal data that are collected through channels, such as the website of APŁ JDS Law Firm located under the domain www.apllegal.pl and e-mails, as well as other means of communication made available to Users.
3. The Administrator ensures the security of the transferred data and the exercise of the Users' rights resulting from the GDPR regulation.
4. When processing the Users' personal data, the Administrator pays particular attention to ensuring that these data are protected against their disclosure to unauthorized persons, taking them by an unauthorized person, processing in violation of the applicable provisions of law, and their change, loss, damage or destruction.

Personal data administrator

5. The administrators of your personal data within the meaning of the provisions on personal data protection are cooperating attorneys-at-law, running law firms under the name: Kancelaria Radcy Prawnego Aneta Pacek-Łopalewska and Kancelaria Radcy Prawnego Joanna Daniłowicz-Starościak, hereinafter referred to as "APŁ JDS Prawnicy Środowiskowi" or jointly "the Administrator".

Personal data

7. What personal data we process:
 - personal data provided by Users as part of e-mail correspondence or during telephone conversations;
 - data collected automatically – during the use of the website by the Users, some personal data may be obtained automatically (e.g. IP address, device and

browser data). Such data is collected using cookies and other similar technologies.

Purposes and bases for data processing

8. The Users' personal data will be processed for the purpose of performing the contract for the provision of legal services concluded with the Client of legal advisors cooperating as APŁ JDS Environmental Lawyers (pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR), as well as for marketing purposes related to the legitimate interests of APŁ JDS Environmental Lawyers, including those related to the services presented on the website of APŁ JDS Environmental Lawyers (pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) and security claims, as well as for the purposes of fulfilling legal obligations, in particular accounting obligations (pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR).

Transfer of personal data

9. We never transfer your data, sell it or exchange it for any purposes, including marketing with other entities. Your data may only be transferred to trusted partners, i.e. external companies acting on our behalf, m.in IT service providers. The data you provide to third parties ("Trusted Partners") is only used to provide you with our Services. Such entities process data on the basis of a contract concluded with us and only in accordance with our instructions, our Privacy Policy and information security standards.
10. In addition, your data may be transferred to entities authorized to obtain them on the basis of the applicable law, offices and bodies authorized to process data on the basis of special provisions of law, e.g. law enforcement authorities in the event of a request by an authority on an appropriate legal basis.

Data retention period

11. Personal data may be processed for the period necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes of processing, in particular for the duration of the contract and the statute of limitations for legal claims, as well as for the period required by law or until the consent is withdrawn – in the case of data processed on the basis of consent.

Rights of data subjects

12. Each owner of personal data whose data is processed has m.in:
 1. the right to request access to data, rectification of data, to delete data (right to be forgotten),
 2. to restrict data processing,
 3. for data portability.
 4. object to data processing

5. withdraw your consent to data processing.
6. the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (the President of the Personal Data Protection Office), www.uodo.gov.pl.

Obligation to provide data

13. Providing personal data, as well as consent to their processing, is completely voluntary. In some cases, the obligation to provide data results from the provisions of law. Any personal data you provide to us is processed only to the extent and for the purpose to which you have consented. In the event that the User does not provide the data necessary to complete the order and does not consent to their processing, it may not be possible to complete the order.

Data security

14. We ensure that the technical and organizational measures necessary to ensure the confidentiality, integrity, accountability and continuity of the processed data are in place and supervise compliance with data protection rules, access control and security procedures.

Cookies

15. The website www.apllegal.pl uses cookies and other tracking technologies. Detailed information on the processing of data obtained with the use of cookies and other tracking technologies can be found in the Cookie Policy published on the website.

16. We reserve the right to make changes to this Privacy Policy at any time. The current version will be published on the website.

COOKIES POLICY

1. The www.aplegal.pl website (the "Website") does not automatically collect any information, except for the information contained in cookies.
2. Cookies are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the Website User's end device and are intended for the use of the website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, the time they are stored on the end device and a unique number.
3. The entities placing cookies on the User's end device and gaining access to them are the operators of the "APŁ JDS Environmental Lawyers" Website – attorneys-at-law running cooperating law firms entitled: Aneta Pacek-Łopalewska Law Firm and Joanna Daniłowicz-Starościak Law Firm (hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Operator").
4. Cookies are used to improve functionality (create statistics that help to understand how Users of the Website use it, which allows for improving its structure).
5. There are two main types of cookies used on the Website: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. "Session" cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until logging out, leaving the website or turning off the software (web browser). "Persistent" cookies are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
6. In many cases, the software used to browse websites (web browser) allows cookies to be stored on the User's end device by default. Users can change their cookie settings at any time. These settings may be changed, in particular, in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of the web browser or to inform about each time they are placed on the Website User's device. Detailed information on the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the settings of the software (web browser).
7. Restrictions on the use of cookies in the web browser may affect some of the functionalities available on the websites.
